

**VETERINARY MEDICAL SCHOOL PREREQUISITE COURSES TIME LINE**

This **example of a typical 3 year plan** is designed to be used with **the prerequisite courses pdf** and **the individual veterinary school websites**.

For students who start pre-health professions after freshman year it is common to have a **bridge year or years after undergraduate school** during which you continue to prepare for and apply to professional schools. **Regardless of when you begin, plan on at least 3 years to prepare for professional school.**
